<b>QUALITY</b>	Whilst every care is taken to supply stock of the highest quality to name, no warranty shall be given or implied as to the quality, true to name or condition of the goods supplied. The company will not be responsible for the condition or quality of the goods after delivery by the company or collection by the customer or for any contingent or consequential loss.
<b>PLANT SIZE</b>	All plant sizes are estimated and may vary slightly from those on all documentation.
